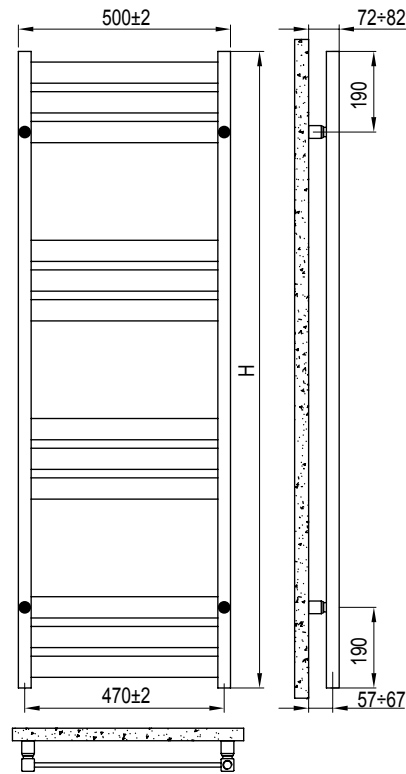

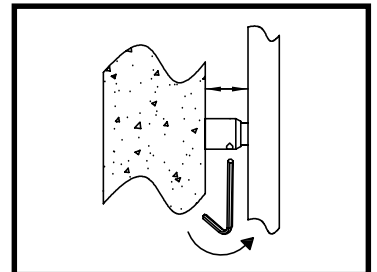
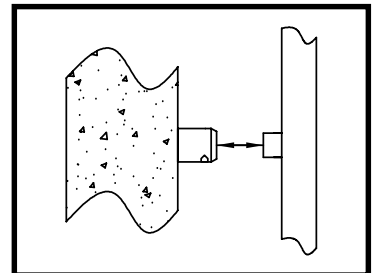

### Pipe Centres

Pipe centres left to right	=	width less 30mm
Pipe centres from wall	=	57mm - 67mm
Depth from wall	=	72mm - 82mm



# 1. Unpack & Inspect

This product should have reached you in perfect condition. Please carefully unpack and inspect this radiator and all fittings. Your point of purchase must be notified of any shortages or damage within 28 days of delivery.

# 3. Fix Brackets

Using the dimensions in the diagrams overleaf, the two top brackets are positioned at 470 mm apart and 190 mm down from the top of the towel rail.

Mark the positions on the wall, and offer up the radiator to check before drilling. Ensure they are horizontally level then using a suitable drill bit, screws and plugs hang the bracket sleeves on the wall. Slot in the radiator to check the positions. To firmly fix the radiator, tighten the grub screws on the side of the brackets to secure.

We suggest you fix the top two brackets, then holding the radiator in place, mark the position for the bottom two brackets to ensure accuracy then fix.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

**It is essential that all brackets are level and square prior to hanging the radiator to ensure a vertical alignment for connecting the pipework.**

# 2. Contents

#### You should have:

- 1 Radiator
- 4 Wall Bracket
- 1 Manual Airvent

#### You will need:

- Tape measure
- Electric drill and bits
- Spirit level

*The fixing kits (screws and dowels) are suitable for compact walls or hollow bricks. Please ensure suitable fixings are used for the correct wall type.*

# 4. Hang & Commission Radiator

When commissioning your radiator on an indirect/closed system we recommend using a suitable quality and quantity of mixed metal inhibitor to protect against scale & corrosion.

**Damage caused to systems not protected by a suitable inhibitor will not be covered by manufacturer's guarantee.**

**PLEASE NOTE:** Systems using micro bore pipe work must have adequate pressure and flow rates for the number and style of radiators on the system.
