

This towel rail can be hung left or right-handed.



### **Pipe Centres**

Pipe centres left to right	=	50mm
Pipe centres from wall	=	57mm - 67mm
Depth from wall	=	95mm - 105mm

### 1. Unpack & Inspect

This product should have reached you in perfect condition. Please carefully unpack and inspect this towel rail and all fittings. Your point of purchase must be notified of any shortages or damage within 28 days of delivery.

# 2. Contents

- 4 Bracket Studs "**B**"
- 4 Bracket Sleeves "**A**"
- 4 Spacers "C"
- 4 Screws "D"



- Spirit level

### 3. Preparing Towel Rail

Remove rubber protectors on the studs on the rear of the towel rail. Slide spacer "C" onto stud followed by threaded Bracket Stud "B". PLEASE NOTE:

This needs to be hand tightened only, DO NOT USE PUMP PLIERS.


# 4. Installing Towel Rail

Mark position of brackets on wall. From left to right, measure width of towel rail less 75mm in from shorter side to the nearest bracket and 125mm to the furthest (see **Fig 1**).

From the top of required position measure 95mm down and 95mm up from the required base of the towel rail for the bottom fixing (see **Fig 2**).

Drill & fix the bracket sleeves and check that they are level

Lift and fit towel rail as per Fig 3 (below), and tighten grub screws "D".



**PLEASE NOTE:** It is essential that all brackets are level to ensure a vertical alignment for connecting the pipework.

# 5. Commission

Please Note: In accordance with Part L1 2006 of the Building Regulations and BS7593:1992 code of practice for the treatment of hot water and central heating systems, we strongly recommend flushing the heating system post installation of new radiators and then adding the correct quantity and type of inhibitor for use with your radiator and system to prevent corrosion. Damage caused to systems not protected by a suitable inhibitor will not be covered by manufacturer's guarantee.

### **Terms & Conditions**

All products must be inspected once removed from the packaging and your point of purchase notified within 28 days of delivery of any scratches, blemishes or other damage. Your point of purchase will then agree appropriate action.

Imperfect radiators should therefore not be fitted and your point of purchase will not accept responsibility for replacement of scratched or damaged radiators once they have been fitted. This includes any consequential loss or cost of fitting.

If your point of purchase are not notified within 28 days of the date on the signed delivery note then it will be deemed that they have fully complied with their obligations and claims will not be considered.
